



Documents and info you'll need:

- Social Security numbers for your children or dependents
- Child-care expense receipts and records
- Self-employed or business expenses (for money you spent on things like your home office, business travel, or office supplies)
- · Records of payments you made to employees, freelancers, or contractors
- Self-employed or business income (1099-MISCs, 1099-Ks, or other records of money you made)
- 1099-INT (for bank account interest)
- 1099-B (for stocks or investments you sold)
- Rental property expense receipts (for money you spent on things like repairs, advertising, and equipment rental)
- Rental property income records (for rent or lease payments you received)
- 1098-T (for college expenses or tuition)
- Receipts for other qualified education expenses

Itemizing deductions? You might also need receipts or records for:

• Charitable donations

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- Vehicle registration fee
- Medical expenses

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
